### **Meet Jermaine Galloway, the Tall Cop**

Officer Galloway has been working against drug and alcohol abuse problems in communities for the past two decades. Now a Texan by choice, he worked in Idaho law enforcement for over 18 years. Since 2009, Officer Galloway has won four national awards and one international award for his work. On average, he gives more than 200 presentations per year. He has also conducted more than 8,400 community scans at a variety of locations.
